2022 APPROPRIATION REVISED STATUTORY TRANSFER TO THE NATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION: BUDGET DETAILS

- 1. The National Assembly has approved the sum of Four Billion, Five Hundred Million Naira (N4,500,000,000.00) only, being Statutory Transfer to the National Human Rights Commission in the Federal Government of Nigeria 2022 Appropriation Act.
- 2. The approved details of the Statutory Transfer for the heads of expenditure are as set out in the document attached herewith.
- 3. The detailed estimates of the Appropriation as approved by the National Assembly, shall apply only for purposes specified therein, subject to the provisions of the Appropriation Act, 2022.
- 4. In the event that the implementation of any of the projects intended to be undertaken under this Act cannot be completed without virement, such virement shall only be effected with the prior approval of the National Assembly.
- 5. This document formally conveys detailed estimates of approval of the National Assembly 2022 Appropriation in the sum of Four Billion, Five Hundred Million Naira (N4,500,000,000.00) only, which represents Statutory Transfer to the National Human Rights Commission.
